

INSURE: Intubate, Surf, Extubate

- No sedatives, sweet-ease can be used.
- Use an ET tube 1 size smaller.
 Ex: Patient requires a 3.0, use a 2.5 for INSURE
- Insert to a depth of (Weight + 5.5) at the gum.

Standardizing the INSURE technique for our clinical practice and avoid the need of mechanical ventilation

- Confirm ET tube position by auscultation, colorimetric CO₂ detector.
 No CXR
- Attach the appropriate size "bone" securing device around the ETT for stability.
 No taping is necessary: double & triple check the ET tube position before surfactant.
- Bag surfactant in 2-3 aliquots.
- Wait till SpO₂ are in goal range at FiO2 < 40%.
- Remove the ET tube to non-invasive respiratory support.
